## NOTICE OF FILING AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 24-ERP-06 June 11, 2024

Petition of Liberty Utilities (New England Natural Gas Company) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities for approval of its 2024 annual gas Emergency Response Plan filed pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 85B and 220 CMR 19.04(1).

On May 15, 2024, Liberty Utilities (New England Natural Gas Company) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("Company") filed its 2024 gas Emergency Response Plan ("ERP") with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department"). This filing was made pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 85B and 220 CMR 19.04(1). The purpose of ERPs is to ensure that each gas company is adequately and sufficiently prepared to restore service to its customers in a safe and reasonably prompt manner during an emergency event. 220 CMR 19.00. The Department has docketed this matter as D.P.U. 24-ERP-06.
