

Important Notice Regarding Gas Rates

Beginning November 1, 2018, customer bills will reflect a per therm charge associated with the monthly decoupling adjustment in connection with the Department of Public Utilities pricing structure mandate to promote energy efficiency. Residential bills will reflect a rate of \$0.0407 per therm; customer bills in 40 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0304 per therm; and customer bills in the 50 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0275 per therm.

In addition, beginning November 1, 2018, the Company's cost of gas will increase from the currently effective \$0.3116 per therm to \$0.3642 per therm. Last year's peak season cost of gas price in November 2017 was \$0.3102 per therm. If your bill contains any gas usage prior to November 1st, your cost of gas will reflect pricing from both periods. The cost of gas is a straight pass through cost on which Liberty Utilities makes no profit.
