### Important notice:

Revenue Decoupling Adjustment Factors for the 2026 Off-Peak Period, May 1, 2026 through October 31, 2026.

#### Fall River and North Attleboro service area:

Beginning May 1st, your cost of gas will decrease from \$1.3188 per therm to \$0.5198 per therm. Last year's off peak-season price in May 2025 was \$0.2954 per therm. If your bill contains any gas usage prior to May 1st, your cost of gas will reflect pricing from both periods. The cost of gas is a straight pass through cost in which Liberty makes no profit.

Your revenue decoupling adjustment (RDAF), in connection with the Department of Public Utilities pricing structure mandate to promote energy efficiency, for Residential bills will reflect a rate of \$0.0481 per therm; customer bills in 40 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0569 per therm, and customer bills in the 50 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0130 per therm. As a result of the RDAF, the average Residential Heating customer will experience an increase of approximately, \$0.06 per month, or 0.14 percent during the off-peak period.

If your bill contains any gas usage prior to May 1st, your cost of gas will reflect pricing from both periods. The cost of gas is a straight pass through cost in which Liberty makes no profit.

Your revenue decoupling adjustment (RDAF), in connection with the Department of Public Utilities pricing structure mandate to promote energy efficiency, for Residential bills will reflect a rate of \$0.0481 per therm; customer bills in 40 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0569 per therm, and customer bills in the 50 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0130 per therm. As a result of the RDAF, the average Residential Heating customer will experience an increase of approximately, \$0.05 per month, or 0.13 percent during the off-peak period.
