

# Important Notice Regarding Gas Rates

Beginning May 1, 2021, customer bills will reflect a per therm charge associated with the monthly decoupling adjustment in connection with the Department of Public Utilities pricing structure mandate to promote energy efficiency. Residential bills will reflect a rate of \$0.0499 per therm, customer bills in 40 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0506 per therm, and customer bills in the 50 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0134 per therm.

Also beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>, your cost of gas will decrease from \$0.4547 per therm to \$0.2300 per therm. Last year's off-peak season price in May 2020 was \$0.1523 per therm. If your bill contains any gas usage prior to May 1<sup>st</sup>, your cost of gas will reflect pricing from both periods. The cost of gas is a straight pass through cost in which Liberty makes no profit.
